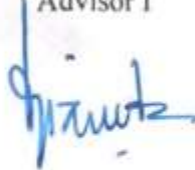

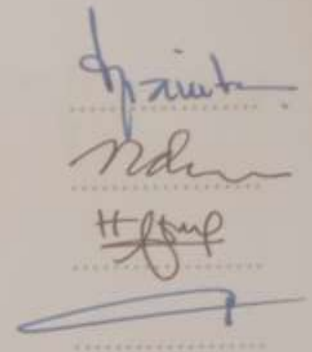

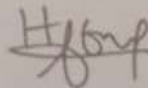

ABSTRACT

The ellipsis emerges as more than a mere trio of dots; it embodies the art of omission, the rhythm of speech, and the intrigue of the unsaid, its elevating written expression to new heights. this study examine ellipsis in the novel "the witcher the last wish" by Andrzej Sapkowski. The aim of writing this study is to to identify ellipsis structures found in the novel and to analyze the most dominant type of ellipsis used in the novel, this study method uses is descriptive qualitative to analyze the data. The data collection is done by reading the witcher: the last wish novel several times, from the dialogue between the character that may contain ellipsis, and using calculation to determine the most dominant type of ellipsis. the theory used is McCarthy theory three types of ellipsis. The result of this study showed that from all three types of ellipsis appear in "the witcher the last wish" novel are nominal ellipsis (36.52%), verbal ellipsis (36.04%), clausal ellipsis (27.44%). This study also showed that becomes the most dominant type with 350 utterance(36.52%), and the least is clausal ellipsis with 263 utterance(27.44%), it is expected that this study to be useful for readers or analysts in the future who are interested with topic related to ellipsis, particularly for non-native readers. It is hoped that this research could assist them in using ellipsis efficiently, due to the significance of the speak informally using a foreign language in everyday life. It is also hoped that this research could assist them in using ellipsis in writing either for academic purpose or daily life purpose.

Ellipsis is a versatile linguistic device used in writing and speech to omit words, phrases, or elements that are unnecessary or can be inferred from the context. Overall, the strategic deployment of ellipsis in literary works and film scripts not only enhances the aesthetic appeal of the text but also serves as a powerful tool for conveying emotion, building suspense, and engaging audiences on a deeper level.
